- Wide variety of curriculum rather than private schools.
- University Fees(Tuition fee/per year):
 - Undergraduate students: 535,800 yen
 - Graduate students(Master's): 535,800 yen
 - Graduate students(Doctoral): 520,800 yen

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 - always aim higher
 - 9 Faculties, 9 Graduate Schools, 4 Institute, 1 Law School, etc.
- Number of stuff: 2568
 (President, Professor, Associate Pro., Technical Staff, etclincluding)
- Number student: Undergraduate 11,359 Graduate 3.671

Degrees Awarded:

- Master (Arts, Education, Econommics, Science, Engineering, etc) in Total 15041 as of March 3, 2006, (980 in Year 2005).
- Doctor (Arts, Education, Econommics, Science, Engineering, etc) in Total 2,590 Old system until June 1991,




Examination on the statistical words from 1984 to 1988, and 1989 to 1993 are summarized in the following graphs.












Between students and teachers
